













hat a year it was for the National Writers Series, with a stunning line-up of 22 New York Times bestselling, Newbery Honor, and Pulitzer Prize-winning authors visiting Traverse City to talk about their newest books.

The National Writers Series of Traverse City is a nonprofit organization dedicated to holding great conversations with today's best authors and building the reading and writing skills of youth.

Today a Reader. Tomorrow a Leader.

Since founding the National Writers Series in 2010, we spread our wings to support young readers and writers in all kinds of ways. We hope that someday, one of our young storytellers will return to the City Opera House to talk about their newest bestselling book and how their love of writing began right here in Traverse City.

RAISING WRITERS

C tarting in 2012, our Raising Writers program has been a home for passionate young writers. The classes and workshops are open to students across Michigan, from Manistee to Grand Traverse, and new in 2023, Antrim County. And that's important as most school districts don't offer creative writing classes. Students enrolled in our semester-long programs have the opportunity to publish their work in the NWS Literary Journal and recite their work at author events. This year, we will publish and celebrate their work at the Alluvion on May 22 from 4:30-6 PM. We hope you can join us in celebrating our young writers!

This spring, we are expanding our Raising Writers program to include a section for grades 3-6, Writers Create!, taught by NWS instructor Kelly Almer. The class will focus on creativity, imagination, and journaling for students to expand their skills in reading, writing, and building stories. We are thrilled to pilot this class in an entirely online format.

All of the students enrolled in NWS Raising Writers classes have the opportunity to publish their work in the *NWS Literary Journal* each May.

We are welcoming back NWS instructor Karin Killian, who will teach a 10-weeklong intensive in literary short story for high school students. This advanced course will focus on writing short stories and analyzing craft. Students will also have the opportunity to work one-onone with the instructor.

NWS instructor David Hornibrook will teach our Antrim Raising Writers for middle school students in grades 5-8. Each week, students will focus on an area in poetry, such as meter, sound, and metaphor. This class is being offered in a hybrid format, meeting both in-person and online.

In addition, we are continuing to grow our Raising Writers program in the Manistee community. NWS instructor Lauren K. Carlson will teach students in grades 6-12 to discover new ways to use their distinct voices, practice reading their work aloud,

and experiment with form and meter throughout the 8-week-long course.

BATTLE OF THE BOOKS

We host a Battle of the Books competition, which involves some 375 fourth and fifth graders in the Grand Traverse County area. Students have fun, learn teamwork, and closely read books in a wide range of genres. A best-selling author is always invited to serve as master of ceremonies, handing out awards, sharing wisdom about storytelling, and signing books.

POETRY WORKSHOPS

In addition to our Raising Writers programs, we also engage fourth and fifth graders in a series of poetry workshops at Blair and Traverse Heights Elementary schools. NWS co-founder and bestselling author Doug Stanton attended Traverse Heights Elementary School where he got his first start in writing. He created and wrote for the school newspaper, the Traverse Heights Traveler, and in that spirit, we began to offer these poetry workshops several years ago as a way for students to express themselves.

This year, the NWS is expanding this program into Manistee and additional underserved schools in Grand Traverse County. Students will learn about poetry, write their own poems, and practice revising their work with the guidance of an NWS teaching artist. Each year, we celebrate the students by publishing their work in a professionally designed poetry journal. We are excited to be expanding this program to include additional schools and more instruction days with students. This program is supported by outstanding volunteers who help guide students in their writing process. SCHOLARSHIPS

Bonnie Jo Campbell, one of Michigan's most acclaimed authors, will talk about her highly anticipated novel, *The Waters.* Readers will meet the eccentric herbalist Hermine "Herself" Zook, who has healed local women of their ailments for generations on an island in the Great Massasauga swamp.

Over the years, Herself has inspired reverence and fear in the people of nearby Whiteheart, Michigan, and even in her own estranged three daughters. Her youngest is the beautiful Rose Thorn, who left her own daughter, eleven-year-old Dorothy "Donkey" Zook, to grow up wild in the swamp, known as "The Waters."

Donkey spends her days searching for truths in the lush landscape and in her math books, waiting for her wayward mother and longing for a father, unaware that family secrets, passionate love, and violent men will flood through the swamp and upend her idyllic childhood.

Bonnie Jo Campbell is the bestselling author of *Once Upon a River,* which was

made into an award-winning feature film.

Her work also includes *Q Road; American Salvage*, a finalist for the National Book Award; *Women and Other Animals*, winner of the AWP prize for short fiction; and a story collection, *Mothers, Tell Your Daughters*. She was awarded a 2011 Guggenheim Fellow and the 2009 Eudora Welty Prize from Southern Review. She and her husband live with their pet donkeys outside of Kalamazoo, Michigan.



Twin Flames Universe: Burned!



of emotional pain expressed by former members was hard to watch and raised more questions than it answered. What exactly is a cult? What is the seductive draw that entraps people? Can law enforcement play a role in helping those who voluntarily join and fork over their savings?

This event will feature Keely Griffin, a survivor of the Twin Flames Universe, and Dr. Janja Lalich, a cult expert. Both who were featured on the Netflix documentary, "Escaping Twin Flames."

Keely will talk about her journey into the online group with the goal of improving her life, relationships and finding her "twin flame," or divinely chosen soulmate. After three years, she left the cult, having lost everything, including her career, savings, and beloved sister, whom she encouraged to join the cult. Keely aspires to advocate for fellow survivors in the legal system and improve education and legislation around coercive control.



Dr. Janja Lalich the author of *Take Back Your Life: Recovering from Cults and Abusive Relationships*, will talk about the draw of cults, the different forms they take, and why they are so hard to escape.

Disinformation is seeping into all facets of our society.

A merica is under attack and the weapon is disinformation. So says Barbara McQuade, a legal analyst for NBC News and MS-NBC, and a University of Michigan law professor.

Barbara writes about how

authoritarians throughout history have manipulated the truth to advance their own agendas in her new book, *Attack From Within*—the psychological tactics they use, why they work, and how the digital age is making the threat more potent everyday. She also offers solutions and aims to inspire a national conversation about renewing this country to a democracy.

Barbara McQuade is a University of Michigan Law School professor, her alma mater, and teaches criminal law, criminal procedure, national security, and data privacy. She is also a legal analyst for NBC News and MSNBC, and a co-host of the podcast #SistersInLaw. From 2010 to 2017, she served as U.S Attorney for the






He has written 25 award-winning, international bestsellers. Many are destined for the small and big screen. He lives in California with his wife of 31 years.



LET THE GAMES BEGIN!

uring the winter months, the NWS Battle of the Books program engages hundreds of fourth and fifth graders in reading fun! Kids read incredible stories together, and learn book facts to prepare for an all-day, heart-pounding competition on April 13 at Traverse City West High School.

The Battle of the Books season begins in December when teams of 4-6 kids form under the leadership of a coach, usually a wonderful parent (thank you!). In January, there's the Book Handout–a special night when teams follow a series of fun activities that reveal their official battle books as they go. Hosted at Traverse Area District Library, the Book Handout sends off each team with a bag of eight books (provided by NWS free of charge) and new friendships.

With books in hand, teams meet weekly to read, discuss stories, and strategize. Months of preparation culminate in the Battle of the Books Tournament on April 13. At the Tournament, teams rotate through four events that challenge their book knowledge, creativity, and teamwork skills. At day's end, the kids gather to crown the top-scoring teams, celebrate the fun of reading together, and meet the bestselling author of a book they read.




Battle of the Books makes reading fun, from creative team names and outfits to team problem-solving.
