CELEBRATING 15 YEARS OF GREAT CONVERSATIONS



WELCOME BOOK LOVERS!

It seems hard to believe, but we're celebrating 15 years of the National Writers Series this year.

It was actually sixteen years ago when my husband, Doug, and I, and friend Grant Parsons brainstormed the idea around our kitchen counter.

The idea for creating a special place for up-close, personal, intimate, smart, and surprising conversations with writers began in May 2009, when Doug was on a nationwide book tour for *Horse Soldiers*, the story of a dozen US Army Special Forces soldiers who went to Afghanistan in 2001, shortly after the Twin Towers, and America, were attacked. The story was retold in the movie *12 Strong*, adapted from Doug's book.

Horse Soldiers was an instant bestseller and would eventually spend about 3 months at #1 on the New York Times bestseller list, but the turnout at Doug's bookstore tour stops was often disappointing. The book tour, as it had existed for at least two decades, was

no longer working, for a lot of reasons. He thought there must be a better way. On tour, he asked readers, bookstore owners, and event producers what

made events successful for them, and he brought what he learned back to Traverse City, and we crafted what we believe is the best book tour experience an author can have in the US. Our testimonials from NWS guests bear this to be true.

Meanwhile, while Doug was on this tour, Paulette Parsons and I organized an event for him at the City Opera House–a homecoming in his hometown, complete with Cook's House donated appetizers and live music. We put up a bunch of posters around town. The Opera House was packed to the rafters. Major Mark Mitchell, a key figure in *Horse Soldiers*, was on stage with Doug and Grant Parsons, and the conversation was stunning.

Doug's feeling, as a reporter with hundreds of interviews under his belt, was that NWS wouldn't feature facile Q&A's but dig into what it felt like for the writer, for all of us, to be alive at this very moment, right now, our hopes and dreams and fears, and to talk about the book as a record of this. We'd focus on these questions and the writer's craft. The event ended with a \$2,000 profit which was donated to a local school.

Doug was so excited that he immediately cold-called Elmore Leonard at his home. Elmore answered his Princess phone in his office and said "Yes" when Doug asked him and his son, Peter, also an author, to appear at NWS. When he introduced them on stage, Doug said, quite suddenly, "This is so much fun, let's do it again!" and announced the creation of something called the National Writers Series of Traverse City. Nobody had any idea what that was, or what it would be. That's how it was born. Out of unexpected joy. My artist friend Deb Sparks drew the logo, and the amazing

Colleen Zanotti did all the graphics, and she's still with us!

Grant Parsons came up with the idea of awarding college scholarships (\$72,000 to date). In 2012, we created a youth literacy program with an eye toward raising generations of readers and writers. We officially formed the nonprofit in 2010 and Amy Alkon, the Advice Goddess columnist, was our first author. Wow, 280+ authors later, we're still going strong!

This is because, and only because, of you, of so many individuals, grantors and businesses who have given us the support to keep turning another page. And of course, there's our amazing staff and board.

All I can say is ... thank you. Thank you so much for letting us do this meaningful work.

WE'RE RAISING WRITERS!

It's a joy that this is too little space to describe all of the incredible impacts of our Raising Writers program.

Perhaps I should begin with our fall elementary poetry workshops, where fourth and fifth graders wrote about the most important aspects of their lives: their families, their love of Christmas, and pet lizards. Or maybe I should start with our College Essay class, in which juniors and seniors crafted acceptancegarnering personal statements for their college applications. And then there's our tenth annual Battle of the Books on the horizon, with teams already reading away in preparation for a day of fabulous, zany, book-based competition.

Truly, the best place to start is with what unifies these programs—the confidence they build. A fourth grade teacher motioned to me while one of her students read his poem in front of the class.

"He's always so shy," she whispered, "I'm amazed he's up there sharing!"

A high school student paused after we finished editing her college essay together. "You know," she said, "I don't think I would have applied to college this year without this class."

And the work continues. This spring, our classes include Sensory Poems and Circle Stories for elementary students, Fractured Fairy Tales for middle schoolers and Fiction Inspired by Myth, Legend and History for high school students. Our Antrim program features Nature Writing for middle schoolers and Poetry for high schoolers, and our Manistee program will feature a class called Publish Me.

And speaking of publishing, our annual NWS *Literary Journal* of student work will launch this spring!

GIVING BACK - VOLUNTEER EXTRAORDINAIRE

"I don't think I've ever missed an event."

Back in the summer of 2009, Mary Ann Warner was scanning the paper to see what was going on in town. She read that Elmore Leonard and his son Peter were coming to the City Opera House to talk about a new book they'd written. She and her husband, Bob, immediately stepped up to volunteer.

"I remember getting there and talking to a man in one of the entryways going into the auditorium. Doug Stanton was in the lobby talking to the whole room of volunteers, and then he called out to welcome Elmer and Peter. Elmore raised his hand, and so did the man next to me. I thought, 'Oh god! Peter Elmore! That's who I've been talking to!' It was funny."

Doug spontaneously announced the National Writers Series at the Elmore Leonard event, and the nonprofit became official the next year.

Mary Ann was 60 that year, having retired from a 35-year career as a nurse. Since then, she believes she's been at every event, which is incredible especially considering there have been 281 events after Elmore Leonard's.

"I don't think I've ever missed an event. It's the first thing that goes into my calendar. It outweighs volunteering at Interlochen, it outweighs the Opera House. I love it!" she said. "I love being among people who enjoy books. I've read ever since I was a kid. I used to go to my grandmother's house up in Alpena. It was my grandpa, my grandma and me. Grandma would buy me two or three books each week, and by the end of the week, I'd have read them all."



Mary Ann arrives early at each event, part of a small book signing team. She usually "flaps" the books, which means using the flap of the book cover to mark the page that the author signs. Another volunteer puts on a Horizon Books discount sticker and another moves them to a pile.

"I've been doing this long enough that I know exactly what I should be doing. I don't ever say, 'I need to go to the restroom right now.' It doesn't work. Doug always calls me the best flapper around.

"Usually, we are pretty intent when we are there with the author. We try to keep them from talking to the guests because it's hard for them to talk and sign their books."

Over the years, Mary Ann has seen all kinds of authors, from an author who brought her own photographer to David Sedaris, who had a conversation with almost every person in the signing line. During it all, she has to keep an eye on the books.

"I'll never forget the time we had some appetizers in the lobby. Some people would pick up the food and then come over and put their drinks on the table and pick up a book with their greasy fingers. I had to tell them, ah, ah, ah!"

GERALDINE BROOKS

A reckoning with grief & a search to find peace

Join Geraldine Brooks for a talk about her heartrending memoir about the loss of her husband, Tony Horwitz, a larger-than-life man and their timeless love that was cut short.

In their early years together, Brooks and Horwitz were foreign correspondents reporting in conflict zones. They eventually settled down to raise two boys on Martha's Vineyard. The life they built was one of meaningful work, good humor, and tendernes. But all of this ended abruptly when, on Memorial Day 2019, Geraldine received the phone call we all dread. Tony – just 60 years old and, to her knowledge, vigorous and healthy – collapsed and died on a sidewalk while on book tour in Washington, D. C.

Three years later, she booked a flight to an island off the coast of Australia with the intention of giving herself time to mourn. There, she pondered how to rebuild her life around the void of Tony's death. And so the book began.

Geraldine Brooks is the author of six novels, including *Horse, People of the Book, Year of Wonders*, and the Pulitzer



Prize-winning *March*. Her writing has collectively sold millions of copies around the world. Born and raised in Australia, Brooks now divides her time between Sydney and Martha's Vineyard.

SCOTT TUROW

Unputdownable courtroom drama at its very best

Turow's new book, **Presumed Guilty,** is a sequel to *Presumed Innocent*, the book that redefined the legal thriller and served as the basis for Apple TV+'s mostwatched drama series ever.

Rusty is a retired judge attempting a third act in life with a loving soon-to-be wife. But the peace that's taken Rusty so long to find evaporates when Bea's young adult son, Aaron, living under their supervision while on probation for drug possession, disappears.

Aaron eventually turns up with a vague story about a camping trip with his troubled girlfriend, Mae. Days later, when she still hasn't returned, suspicion falls on Aaron, and when Mae is subsequently discovered dead, Aaron is arrested and set for trial on charges of first-degree murder.

Bea begs Rusty to return to court one last



time, to defend her son. For Rusty, the question is not whether to defend Aaron, or whether the boy is in fact innocent– it's whether the system to which he has devoted his life can ever provide true justice for those who are presumed guilty.

Turow's books have been translated into more than forty languages, sold more than thirty million copies worldwide, and have been adapted into movies and television projects.

LET THE GAMES BEGIN!

During the winter months, the NWS Battle of the Books program engages hundreds of fourth and fifth graders in reading fun! Kids read incredible stories together, and learn book facts to prepare for an all-day, heart-pounding competition on April 12 at Traverse City West High School.

The Battle of the Books season begins in December when teams of 4-6 kids form under the leadership of a coach, usually a wonderful parent (thank you!). In January, there's the book handout–a special night when teams follow a series of fun activities that reveal their official battle books as they go. Hosted at Traverse Area District Library, the book handout sends off each team with a bag of eight books (provided by NWS free of charge) and new friendships.

With books in hand, teams meet weekly to read, discuss stories, and strategize. Months of preparation culminate in the Battle of the Books Tournament on April 12. At the Tournament, teams rotate through four events that challenge their book knowledge, creativity, and teamwork skills. At day's end, the kids gather to crown the top-scoring teams, celebrate the

fun of reading together, and meet the bestselling author of a book they read.

- NWS proudly broadcasts select author events on IPR and YouTube, and makes them available to public radio stations around the country.
- We are honored to have awarded \$72,000 in scholarships to 54 college-bound students.
- We've hosted 281 author events for onstage conversations over the past 14 years.
- Our Raising Writers program, draws students from a sixcounty area who love to learn about writing.
- Every year dozens of teams are engaged in a creative and fun Battle of the Books. Last year NWS had 370 fourth-and fifthgraders reading and being quizzed on eight books.
