

iven my position as education director, it should be no surprise that fall is my favorite season. The chill in the morning air brings with it all the promise and possibility of the backto-school season, and the memory of excitedly counting down the days to the start of each school year. What new friends might be made? What new things would be learned?

I felt that familiar excitement as I planned the National Writers Series Raising Writers fall classes this year. Students will have more opportunities than ever before to create lasting friendships through a shared love of writing. Our classes include a sequel to our twice-waitlisted (it was just that popular!) screenwriting course for middle schoolers, Antrim County Language Lab where students will conduct linguistic experiments and mad-science wordplay, a collaborative storytelling class for elementary school students, a TTRPG character creation class (think writing for games like Dungeons and Dragons,) and a Once Upon A Boat Class, where students will craft creative nonfiction essays about a sailing day they'll experience together (the most adventurous Raising Writers class yet!) We're also hosting a session of our life-changing **College Essay Class**, which gives high-school juniors and seniors the opportunity to get one-on-one coaching on how to write a competitive admissions essay.

But, that back-to-school buzz isn't the only fall feeling that makes this season wonderful. Halloween, with its explosion of creative costumes, happy haunts, and tantalizing treats is on the way, and Raising Writers is celebrating in style.

We're hosting a Mystery Writing Class and a Spooky Super Short Story Class, where young writers can learn the craft of frightening flash-fiction. And if you're the kind of adult who has already had their own Halloween costume planned for months (quilty,) don't feel left out. Join me for a Horror Writing for Adults Class, in collaboration with Tank Space, where we'll write our best scary stories and share them at an after-class community reading and Halloween party. Need an extra reason to dust off those fake teeth or monster claws? The winner of the costume contest will get a free







Thirteen years ago, former ice hockey star Jimmy Baker quit the game after almost killing an opponent. Now, as the Zamboni driver for the amateur team in his hometown of Bitterfrost, Michigan, he's living his penance. Until the morning when he awakens to the smell of blood...

Jimmy soon finds himself arrested for a brutal double murder. The kicker? He has no memory of the night in question. And as the evidence racks up against him, Jimmy's case is skating on thin ice. Could he have committed such a gruesome crime?

As his defense attorney, Devyn Payne, and the prosecuting detective, Garth Klimmek, race to uncover the truth, time is running out for Jimmy. Because all he can really be sure of is that he is capable of taking a life. The question is, in his blacked-out state, did he take two?

Bryan Gruley is the Edgar-nominated author of six novels - Purgatory Bay, Bleak Harbor, The Starvation Lake Trilogy, and his most recent, Bitterfrost - and one awardwinning work of nonfiction. A lifelong journalist, he shared in The Wall Street Journal's Pulitzer Prize for coverage of the September 11 terrorist attacks. He lives in



eter Matthiessen (1927-2014) is a towering figure of twentieth-century American letters, who achieved so much during his lifetime, in so many different areas, that people have struggled to pin him

down. While ambivalent about his WASP privilege-as a teenager he demanded that his name be removed from the New York Social Register-he attended Yale and cut his teeth in postwar Paris, co-founding The Paris Review as he worked undercover for the CIA. But then, after a rebellious stint as a Long Island fisherman, he escaped into a series of wild expeditions: floating through the Amazon to recover a prehistorical fossil; embedding with a tribe in Netherlands New Guinea; swimming with sharks off the coast of Australia. His novels, were unclassifiable meditations. His nonfiction became legendary: nature books like Wildlife in America as well as advocacy journalism supporting Cesar Chavez, Leonard Peltier, and Native American land claims.

Underlying all Matthiessen's disparate pursuits was the same existential search-to find a cure for "deep restlessness." This was most profoundly articulated in The Snow Leopard, his famous account of a 250-mile wildlife survey across the Himalayas.

In True Nature, Lance Richardson reconstructs the full scope of a spiritual quest that ultimately led Matthiessen, even as he inflicted great pain on his family, to the highest ranks of Zen. Richardson illuminates how the writer's uncanny gifts enabled him to sense connections between ecological decline, racism, and labor exploitation-to express, eloquently and presciently, that "in a damaged



human habitat, all problems merge."

Richardson previously published House of Nutter: The Rebel Tailor of Savile Row. a New York Times Editors' Choice and a 2018 notable title selected by *The Sunday* Times, The Mail on Sunday, Esquire, and the American Library Association. He teaches in the MFA in Writing program at Bennington College, Vermont.





Mitch Albom is an internationally renowned and best-selling author and journalist. His books have collectively sold






n the fiftieth anniversary of the Edmund Fitzgerald's sinking, the bestselling author of *The* Great Halifax Explosion tells the definitive story of the "Mighty Fitz."

Few endeavors have bound time so mercilessly to money as Great Lakes shipping did at its peak, and no vessel had been more perfectly designed to maximize both than the S. S. Edmund Fitzgerald. The Fitzgerald at the time of her launch was the largest ship on the lakes, and she repeatedly broke her own records for the largest loads, the fastest runs, and the biggest season hauls.

But on November 10, 1975, when the "storm of the century" threw 100 mileper-hour winds and 50-foot waves on Lake Superior, the Mighty Fitz found itself at the worst possible place, at the worst possible time. When she sank, she took all 29 men onboard down with her, leaving the tragedy shrouded in mystery for a half century.

In *The Gales of November*, award-winning journalist John U. Bacon presents the definitive account of the disaster, drawing on more than 100 interviews with the families, friends, and former crew mates of those lost. Bacon explores the vital role Great Lakes shipping played in America's economic boom, the uncommon lives the sailors led, the sinking's most likely causes, and the heartbreaking aftermath for those left behind-"the wives, the sons, and the daughters" as Gordon Lightfoot sang in his unforgettable ballad.

The Gales of November is both an emotional tribute to the Fitzgerald's captain and crew and a propulsive,



page-turning narrative history of America's most-mourned shipwreck.

John U. Bacon has authored fourteen books on sports, business, and history, the last seven of which are critically acclaimed national bestsellers, including five New York Times bestsellers. He lives in Ann Arbor and Northern Michigan with his wife and son.
